KANSAS VOTER REGISTRATION

Any person registering to vote in Kansas for the first time is required to provide evidence of United States citizenship. Those already registered to vote are exempt as long as they remain on the voter registration list. A voter whose registration is canceled must submit a citizenship document when re-registering.

VALID CITIZENSHIP DOCUMENTS

These documents are acceptable as evidence of U.S. citizenship for voter registration purposes:

- Driver's license or nondriver's identification card issued by the Division of Vehicles (or an agency of another state if the card indicates that the person has provided satisfactory proof of U.S. citizenship)
- Birth certificate that verifies U.S. citizenship
- Valid or expired U.S. passport or pertinent pages identifying the applicant and passport number
- U.S. naturalization documents or the number of the certificate of naturalization
- Other documents issued by the federal government per the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952
- Bureau of Indian Affairs card number, tribal treaty card number or tribal enrollment number
- Consular report of birth abroad of a citizen of the U.S.
- Certificate of citizenship issued by the U.S. Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services
- Certification of report of birth issued by the U.S. Department of State
- American Indian card with KIC classification issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security
- Final adoption decree showing the applicant's name and U.S. birthplace
- U.S. military record of service showing applicant's place of birth in the U.S.
- Extract from a U.S. hospital record of birth created at the time of birth indicating place of birth in the U.S.

If a citizenship document is deemed unsatisfactory, the applicant may sign a form explaining the inconsistency.
